


MISSION

ABOUT AIPS

AIPS was founded in Paris just before Olympic Games in 1924. This was the occasion where the idea of connecting and unifying sports journalists became reality through the creation of an international association committed to defend their ethical interests and working conditions.

AIPS is today the peak professional body representing the international sports media. Members of AIPS are 161 national sports press associations and over 9,500 professionals around the globe. The headquarters of the association are located in the Olympic Capital of Lausanne (Switzerland), home of the major sports governing bodies. To invest in the education of future generations, AIPS has carried out more than 30 Young Reporters Programmes, a series of intensive seminars organised to cover top sporting events.

Since 2019, AIPS is also founder and organiser of the AIPS Sport Media Awards, the highest international accolade in the sport media industry.








Some of the most important personalities in the sports administration took part in the AIPS Congresses over the years, representing the full variety of the sporting environment.




AIPS SPORT MEDIA AWARDS








MASTERS ON THE FIELD

Since the initial edition held in Shenzhen at the Summer Universiade in 2011 and supported by the Organising Committee of the XXVI Universiade, the City of Shenzhen and International University Sports Federation (FISU), AIPS has organised 32 Young Reporters Programmes, with over 200 Young Reporters from more than 80 nations across 5 continents.

The duration of the programme depends on the calendar of each sporting event and the teaching language is English.

In the space of this enriching experience, buddying journalists are put in front of the numerous situations of pressure occurring in the daily coverage of a sporting event.





DISTANCE LEARNING EDUCATION

In times of Covid-19 outbreak, AIPS e-College is a way to continue the renowned AIPS Young Reporters Programmes, offering chances, tools and answers to the next generation. The AIPS e-College is an innovative distance learning project which marks a new step of AIPS cultural agenda, offering tools, opportunities and answers to the next generation of sports journalists. Reporters from up to **47 countries** took part in the inaugural edition (April 2 -June 2), reaching an average attendance of over **70 journalists**.

Based on free participation, lessons were held twice a week on zoom.us, alternating the interventions of eminent personalities from the sports industry with lessons given by AIPS Mentors.





Thanks to the AIPS customised Newsletter, partners can receive targeted content depending on the editorial requests.


For instance, Chinese partners will be provided with **up to six articles** related to their geographic area or business, available in both **Chinese and English language**.

The AIPS Newsletter is **scheduled on a regular** basis.































With 4 issues per year, the AIPS Magazine is considered one of the most important features in the world of sports journalism. The printed copies are sent to all AIPS Members and Partners.


